## St Bakhita's Day Ethical Sourcing Expo



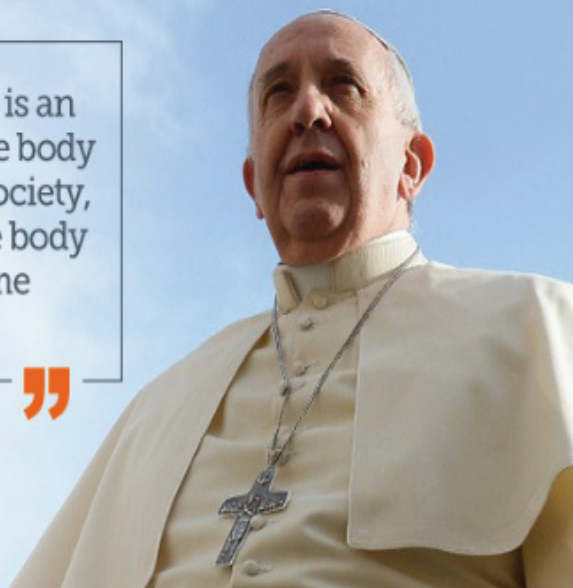
